- 29th annual ride. Sold out on June 11, 2008.
- Untimed, recreational. First event was a time trial between Seattle and Portland City Halls. Jerry Baker won the race.
- 9,500 registered riders
- 2,427 one-day riders
- 7,073 two-day riders
- Total distance (miles) 202.25
- Uphill distance (miles) 30.87
- Uphill altitude (feet) 1,951
- Maximum altitude (feet) 463
- Start: University of Washington E-1 Parking Lot on Montlake Blvd., just north of Husky Stadium.
- Midpoint: Centralia, Washington
- Finish: Holladay Park in northeast Portland, near Lloyd Center.
- 85 medical riders on the course
- 44 states represented (see list below)
 - 6,899 riders from Washington
 - 1,060 riders from Oregon
- Eldest rider: 86.
- Youngest rider: 2 years 5 months.
- 2,716 female riders; 6,512 male riders
- 310 riders have done the event 10+times.
- Riders with the most rides, who participated in each of the 28 rides, are:
 - Jerry Baker (66) of Seattle
 - Paul Wantzelius (59) of Maple Valley
